Explain Reason For Proposed Rule(s): The Division of Criminal Information Network (DCIN) with the North Carolina State Bureau of Investigation is tasked with accessing North Carolina criminal history data, obtaining criminal records of certain individuals, and obtaining automobile registrations and driver's licenses among other specified tasks. While performing these tasks as well as operating within the scope of any other authority given to them, DCIN must follow the protocols contained in the Federal Bureau of Investigation's Criminal Justice Information Services (CJIS) Security Policy. Because that policy is changed frequently, the purpose of these proposed rules is to conform with some of the provisions of the CJIS Security Policy, as well as to make any other grammatical and technical changes to the rules.

8. Procedure for Subjecting a Proposed Rule to Legislative Review: If an objection is not resolved prior to the adoption of the rule, a person may also submit written objections to the Rules Review Commission. If the Rules Review Commission receives written and signed objections in accordance with G.S. 150B-21.3(b2) from 10 or more persons clearly requesting review by the legislature and the Rules Review Commission approves the rule, the rule will become effective as provided in G.S. 150B-21.3(b1). The Commission will receive written objections until 5:00 p.m. on the day following the day the Commission approves the rule. The Commission will receive those objections by mail, delivery service, hand delivery, or email.
